- Enjoy a hearty lunch (I) at **Mrs. Yoder's Kitchen**, where authentic Amish cooking warms your soul.
- Afternoon Visit the beautifully preserved **James A. Garfield National Historic Site**, known as "Lawnfield." Walk through the first official presidential library and experience a home meticulously restored with over 80% original Garfield furnishings. Admire authentic Victorian wallpapers, rare books, and family treasures.
- Evening Return to **Steele Mansion** for more porch sitting, storytelling, and dinner (I) with fellow travelers.

## Day 5 - June 12, 2026
