Drive to Monaghan - Approximately 1.5 hours

Coffee & Tea Break | Hill of Tara

The Hill of Tara has been an important site since the late Stone Age, when a tomb was built there. However, it rose to supreme prominence in the Iron Age (600 BC to 400 AD) and into the Early Christian Period when it became the seat of the high kings of Ireland. All old Irish roads lead to this historical site.






Drive to Galway - Approximately 2.5 hours to Aughnanure Castle - tea break at Westport (Mayo) and see Croagh Patrick Mountain.

Aughnanure has a special connection to Irish harps, as it's believed that the castle served as a gathering place for musicians during its time of prominence. The O'Flaherty clan, known for their patronage of the arts, likely welcomed harpists, whose music would have resonated within the castle's ancient walls, adding to its rich cultural legacy. We will meet renowned traditional harp maker Natalie Surina, who will showcase the intricate art of crafting these exquisite masterpieces. To add to the experience, she will share a few of her favorite Irish tunes, filling the air with the enchanting sounds of the harp.
